INVITATION FOR BIDS

AGGREGATE CRUSHING SERVICES

Notice is hereby given that the Mono County Department of Public Works calls for bids from qualified contractors to provide aggregate crushing services at the Benton Crossing Landfill. In general, the services to be rendered consist of crushing mixed aggregate material that has been stockpiled at the Benton Crossing Landfill, to a size suitable for re-use and recycling (3/4" minus).

1. Bid Packages, which include the Instructions to Bidders and related Exhibits, provide specific requirements for the work. Bid packages are available by contacting the Mono County Department of Public Works by telephone at (760) 932-5453, or by email at tdubliano@mono.ca.gov. The Bid Packages are also posted online at http://www.monocounty.ca.gov/departments/public_works/public_works.html.
2. Each bid shall be made on the Bid Proposal Form furnished by the Mono County Department of Public Works and included in the Bid Package, which requires a set mobilization/demobilization charge, and cost per ton of crushed material. The work will cease once available stockpiles are exhausted, or the not-to-exceed contract limit has been reached.
3. The bid amount should take into account the bidder's cost of furnishing of all labor, supervision, equipment, supplies, materials, transportation, taxes, fees, bonds, and all other items necessary to perform the work and services requested.
4. Bid documents must be received in a sealed, opaque envelope clearly labeled with "AGGREGATE CRUSHING BID" and the name of the Bidder printed on the outside of the envelope. Bids received unsealed or unlabeled will not be considered. Bids submitted by fax transmission will not be considered.
5. Any bids received after the time specified below shall be returned to the bidder unopened. Please be advised that due to the remote nature of central Mono County, "overnight" delivery by the US Postal Service, UPS, FedEx, and other carriers is actually scheduled as a two-day delivery.
6. Bids will be received by the Mono County Department of Public Works, Post Office Box 457, Bridgeport, California, 93517, or by delivery to the Mono County Department of Public Works office, 74 North School Street, Bridgeport, California up to the bid opening time, which has been set as specified below.
7. Bids will be publicly opened on **October 1, 2015 at the hour of 3:00 p.m.** in the Public Works Conference Room, 74 North School Street, Bridgeport, California, and there read aloud and recorded. All interested parties are invited to attend.

8. The successful bidder will be required to enter into a two-year agreement with Mono County. Requests for service will be made on an as-needed basis, with an initial request for mobilization immediately.
9. The services to be provided are a public work within the meaning of the California Labor Code and are subject to the payment of prevailing wages under Labor Code section 1771. Further, no contractor or subcontractor may be listed in a bid proposal or awarded a contract for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 (unless exempt under section 1771.1.) This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.
