ADDENDUM ISSUED ON: September 10, 2015

TO: Prospective Bidders for Aggregate Crushing Services at Benton Crossing Landfill

FROM: Mono County Department of Public Works

The following changes/clarifications shall be made to the Instructions to Bidders and Invitation to Bid:

1. All references to the material specification are hereby changed from $\frac{3}{4}$ " minus to 1" minus. Clarification: this material is **not** intended to meet specification for CalTrans, Section 26 Class 2 Aggregate Base.
2. For each mobilization event, the Contractor shall be assured a minimum of 8,000 tons of crushed material.
3. The County will provide dust control for the grounds surrounding the crushing activities. For the crushing plant itself, Contractor must provide a water tank of at least 4,000 gallons that will be filled by the County as necessary.
4. In Section 9 of the Instruction to Bidders, the requirement for a "three-year agreement" is hereby changed to a two-year agreement, in accordance with the Invitation to Bid.
5. Clarification: The County has a chemical toilet on site for use by Contractor. Contractor will be granted permission to utilize existing office space at the site as necessary.
